GTAP 6

- Unilateral trade data: IMF, Balance of Payments Statistics
- Fill in missing values.
- Bilateralize on pro rata basis.

GTAP 7

- Bilateral trade data, CPB/OECD.
- Combine bilateral and unilateral trade data.
- Bilateral data:
 - for 2003 not 2004
 - 11 sectors not 21
 - 30 countries not 167

CBP Contribution

- 30 countries × 30 countries × 11 (or 12) sectors, complete, reconciled
- 30 reporters × 264 partners × 11 (or 13) sectors × 2 directions, incomplete, unreconciled

Margin Services

- margin *v* non-margin transport services
- reconciliation between margin services data and merchandise trade data
- apportionment of margin services across freight commodity, origin, and destination

Travelers' Expenditures

- a commodity or a mode of trade?
- allocate across the GTAP commodities
- no data on commodity composition
- source of unexpected flows
- confuses comparisons
- problematic interactions with other data

Procedure

- Fill in gaps in unilateral services trade data.
- Reconcile bilateral services trade data with unilateral.
- Apportion travelers' expenditures across commodities.
- Expand all services trade data to 226 countries.
- Reconcile margin services with merchandise trade.
- Apportion margin services across merchandise flows.

Reconciliation

• IMF:

- trade between non-reporters
- trade between reporters and non-reporters
- total exports of reporters to all reporters
- total imports of reporters to all reporters

• OECD:

pattern of trade between reporters
