TRANSPORTATION

It is possible to reach Venice by plane through two main airports - the Venice Marco Polo Airport or the Treviso Canova Airport - by train, or by road.

Arriving from Venice Marco Polo Airport

Venice Marco Polo Airport is approx. 14 Km from Venice City Centre and is connected to the city by various forms of public transport; *vaporetto* (waterbus), water taxi, bus and road taxi.

From Venice Marco Polo Airport to Venice by Water Bus

The Alilaguna water bus leaves at least once every hour, and the journey time to the Lido and to Rialto is 60 minutes, to St. Mark's Square and to Zattere 80 minutes. Tickets, \in 13,00 per person – one way (luggage included), can be bought on board or from the desk in the arrivals hall and landing stage.

The Orange Line of the Alilaguna stops also at *Guglie*, which is just 5 minutes from the San Giobbe Campus. It runs from 8.00 am to 11.40 pm and the journey time from the airport to *Guglie* is 42 minutes.

From Venice Marco Polo Airport to Venice by Water Taxi

Prices are based on the number of people in the taxi and can vary after 20.00 and on Sundays and public holidays. The price is approx. € 100,00 for up to 4 people to the City Centre directly to your hotel with a journey time of approx. 30 minutes.

From Venice Marco Polo Airport to Venice-Piazzale Roma by Bus

The ACTV bus line 5 travels between the airport and Piazzale Roma - Venice bus terminal, leaving at 10, 25, 40 and 55 minutes after the hour, with a journey time of 25 minutes. Tickets (€ 3,00 luggage included) can be bought from the desk in the arrivals hall. The bus departs in front of the main airport building.

The ATVO Express coach service (blue bus) from the airport to Piazzale Roma-Venice bus terminal departs approx. every 30 minutes with a journey time of 20 minutes. Tickets (€ 3,00 luggage included) can be bought from the desk in the arrivals hall. The bus departs in front of the main airport building.

On arrival to Piazzale Roma by bus, the walking distance to the San Giobbe Campus or to the surrounding hotels is at most 15 minutes.

From Venice Marco Polo Airport to Venice - Piazzale Roma by Taxi

A private taxi from the airport to Piazzale Roma will cost approx. € 30,00. The Taxi Rank is located in front of the main airport building. Road Taxis are available 24 hours a day.

Arriving from Treviso Canova Airport

From Treviso Canova Airport to Venice - Piazzale Roma by Bus

The ATVO Express coach service (blue bus) runs between the airport and Piazzale Roma (Venice bus terminal) and coincide with Ryanair and Transavia flights. The cost of a ticket is \in 5,00 for one way and \notin 9,00 return, valid 7 days (luggage included). Tickets can be bought at the ticket office in the arrivals hall. The journey time is approx. one hour and 10 minutes in good traffic conditions.

From Treviso Canova Airport to Venice - Piazzale Roma by Taxi

A taxi from the airport to Piazzale Roma (Venice bus terminal) will cost approx. € 70,00. You will find road taxis available in front of the airport terminal.

From Treviso Canova Airport to Venice-Santa Lucia Railway Station by Train

The number 6 ACTT bus provides public service from Treviso airport to the local train station. The bus runs every 30 minutes and has a journey time of approx. 20 minutes. The cost of a ticket is € 1,00 and can be bought in the arrivals hall.

Trains from Treviso Railway station leave approx. every 30 minutes. Journey time is around 35 minutes and tickets cost € 2,35.

Arriving by road to Piazzale Roma-Venice

Piazzale Roma is the public bus terminal and parking area in Venice. On leaving Piazzale Roma you will be able to take a private water taxi or the public water transport to the rest of the city. The walking distance from Piazzale Roma to the San Giobbe Campus or to the surrounding hotels is at most 15 minutes.

Arriving by train to Venice Santa Lucia Train Station

Venice - Santa Lucia is the central train station for Venice. On leaving the train station you will be able to take a private water taxi or the public water transport to the rest of the city. The walking distance from Santa Lucia Train Station to the San Giobbe Campus or to the surrounding hotels is at most 10 minutes.

Public transportation within the city

Vaporetti (waterbus) follow different routes around the City. They run every 10-20 minutes, according to the route schedules posted at every stop, less frequently after midnight. They run 24 hours a day.

The waterbus lines 41, 42, 51 and 52 stop approx. in front of San Giobbe Campus.

These lines are called "gira città" because their circular route connects Venice's entire perimeter and makes the Conference venue easily reachable from the railway station, from *Piazzale Roma* bus terminal, from the central area of Venice where hotels, restaurants and tourist attractions are located.
